D'fhéadfadh roinnt arda a bheith sna cosáin chomh maith le dromchla corrach atá in ann a bheith garbh le roinnt constaicí ar nós fréamhacha ag gobadh amach, carraigeacha, srl. Tá na bealaí seo oiriúnach do dhaoine a bhfuil leibhéal measartha aclaíochta acu chomh maith le roinnt taitní a bheith ag siúl. Moltar do dhaoine coisbheart agus éadaí siúil allamuigh ar leith a chaitheamh.

DESCRIPTION

GRÁD
MODERATE

These trails may have some climbs and may have an uneven surface where the going is rough underfoot, with some obstacles such as protruding roots, rocks, etc. The routes are appropriate for people with a moderate level of fitness and some walking experience. Specific outdoor walking footwear and clothing is recommended.

Tosaíonn an siúlóid seo ag Reilig Mhaírois. Tá ballaí teampaill ina seasamh sa reilig fós. Ceaptar gur sa séú haois a tógadh an séipéal seo. In aice láimhe tá suíomh an teampaill Protastúnach, áit ina raibh teampall agus scoil a tógadh in 1855.

Leanann an siúlóid siar ó dheas trí Thrá Mhaírois go Gob a Phuint. Uaidh sin leanann an siúl le cladach achrannach go dtí an Trá Mhóir. Siúil ar an trá ar feadh 500m, thar góilín bheag agus céibh, cas faoi chlé ag teach beag bán le taobh na farraige agus cosán amach ar an mbóthar. Ag an bpointe seo is féidir a.) casadh ar dheis suas an spior bhealach i dtreo ceann Mása, tharr an Stáisiún Aimsire. Tá sean áit faire ó aimsir an chogaidh ag an gceann agus is féidir feiceáil trasna go hoileán Mhic Dara, leis an séipéal ársa. b.) cas ar chlé le dul ar ais chuig Reilig Mhaírois. Téann an bóthar seo trí Dhubh Ithir agus síos go dtí an chéibh ag trá Mhaírois, le radhcanna álainne trasna ar na Beann Beola, Iorras Beag agus go leor oileáin.

This walk starts at Moyrus cemetery. The remains of the church in the cemetery are believed to date back to the 6th century. Close by is the site of the church set up by the Irish Missions in 1855. Walkers should head in a south westerly direction across Moyrus Beach to Gob a Phuint. From here the walk continues along the rocky shoreline to an Trá Mhóir. Walk along the beach and at about 500m past a small inlet and pier, turn left beside a white seaside cottage. The small bóithrín will bring you up to the main road. From this point you can a) turn right up to Mace Head past the Atmospheric Research Station. There is an old wartime 'lookout' shelter on the headland and you can see across to St. Macdara's island with its iconic oratory. b) turn left back to Moyrus cemetery. This road runs through Dubhithir and down to the pier at Moyrus beach, affording beautiful views across the Twelve Bens, Errisbeg and many islands.

FÓGRA: Is réadmhaoin phríobháideach atá i gcuid den réadmhaoin atá á trasnú ag Lúibín Garumna. Tá cead isteach le caoinhead na n-úinéirí/sealbóirí talún uile ar an gconair. Tá sé intuigthe go dtéann daoine isteach ar an talamh le cead agus le toiliú an úinéara talún, agus pé chomh minic a théann siad isteach, nó pé mhéid daoine atá i gceist, ní de cheart a dhéanann siad sin. Is cuma cé mhéid caiteachais a dhéanann páirtithe an chomhaontaithe seo nó daoine aonair ar an gconair atá á húsáid, ní athrófar an leagan amach sin. Mar fhianaise bhreise ar an mbealach isteach a bheith ceadmhach, dúnfar an chonair ar an 27 Feabhra gach bliain le comhaontú na n-úinéirí talún. Níl dada san fhógra seo a mbeidh éifeacht aige nó a dhíríonn ar aon cheart slí poiblí atá ann cheana.
